The original 30's "Schmidt" back bar still remains in the main bar, there is still the feeling of being comfortable there, but, many other things have changed, with the addition of new parts to the building. A large portion of the ceiling on the main floor was removed, and now you go up the steps to a large Game Room & Sports Bar overlooking the original downstairs area. Pool, darts, foos ball, and other video games, make it undoubtedly one of the finest such rooms, in the area. Two - 12 foot Big Screen TV's, for sports, have been added, with Surround Sound.

The back of the building was entirely removed and replaced with a new 3-level LAKE-SIDE addition. Old restrooms were removed and magnificent, large, clean, ones with many mirrors in the ladies, replace them. The Ladies Love Them !

There is also a third level 4 season porch and patio area with a great view of the lake. A family dining area offers breakfast, lunch and dinners. The new lakeside dining room and deck offers a non-smoking, quiet, non-bar environment and is decorated with historic pictures from the Forest Lake areas past.

The Garden Level, "Office Lounge", is deocrated in a 1930's style, with a 'waterfall' patio. Specialties include, Martinis, Mojitos, Old Fashions, Manhattans, and you may dine in the Office, while you listen to "Rat Pack" music . If you're a little late for supper at home, "Honey, I was working late, at the Office." Parties may be booked, for these new areas.

Back to the 'BIKER BAR'. tv camera surveillance is on hand, to make sure there is no problem with leaving your bike, in the large parking lot. A 'V. I. B.' (VERY IMPORTANT BIKER) card may be obtained - FREE - offering discounts, purchases, with drawing for prizes such as Laker shirts, gift certificates, and Jack Daniels merchandise. Drink specials are an everyday happening, with truly GREAT HAPPY HOURS.

There is a absolutely a huge variety of beers and liquors on hand, featuring the new Budweiser Biker Bottles, and good ole JACK DANIELS.

For entertainment, there is Karoake, Bar Bingo, Texas Hold'em, and a LIVE MUSIC card unequaled in the area, featuring bands 6 nites a week.

The New Forest Laker has all of the above, and, an excellent staff of chefs, servers, and bartenders, to fit your needs wherever you are in the building. We recently attended a Jack Daniels dinner, consisting of Spicy Jack Daniels Shrimp Scampi, Jack
