I have just been informed of a circumstance that may have a dire effect including the potential loss of records of many MIAs. Dr. Michael Charney, noted forensic anthropologist, who worked on many MIA cases, kept many records and files on his work. After his death, these files were confiscated by the Larimer County (Colorado) Sheriff's Office. Reason being that they also contained files on county cases. The MIA files should have been given to a colleague of his for safekeeping. This has not happened and now, Larimer County wants to send these files to CILHI for disposion. I would like to alert anyone, especially family members, that these records may be lost forever. I have no idea on the number of files but there may be 50 plus records. This is important to family members that this information belongs to them and they may not know that this is happening. I feel the families should have these records and no one else. The files, if not already sent to CILHI, are held at the Larimer County (Colorado) Sheriff's Office, Division CSI, (Crime Scene Investigation).If anyone has information about families who worked with Dr. Charney, please get the word out. I will try to get more information as well and can help as a Colorado point of contact.
