So thanks again to all the people that write for the paper and I would like to send a special thanks to Martha Cothren for teaching her students why they have the rights they do.

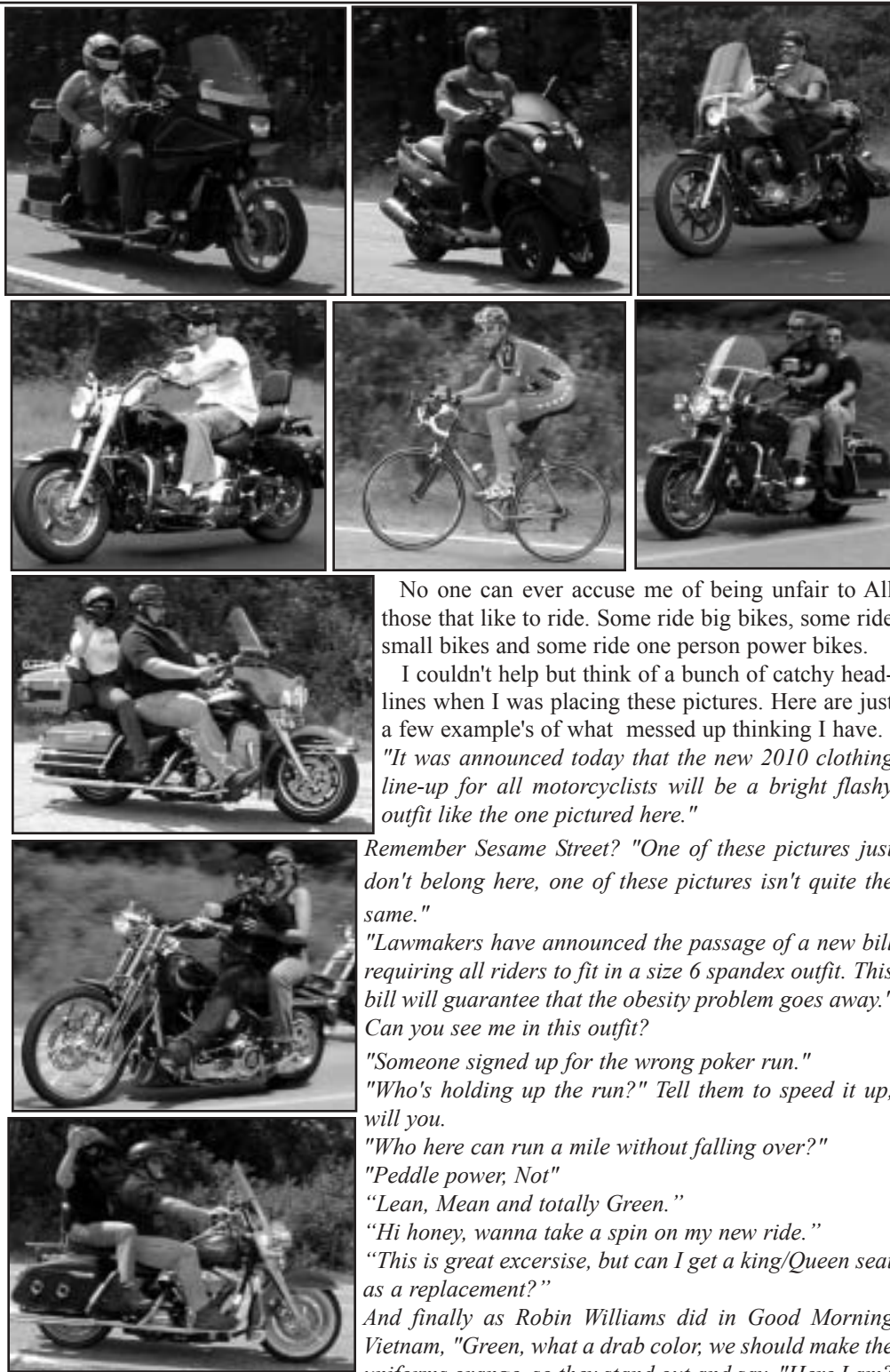
I am once again proud to tell people that I am a Veteran.
