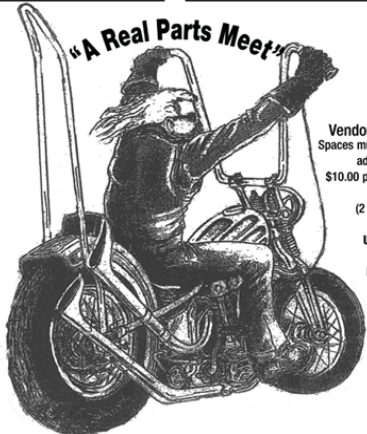

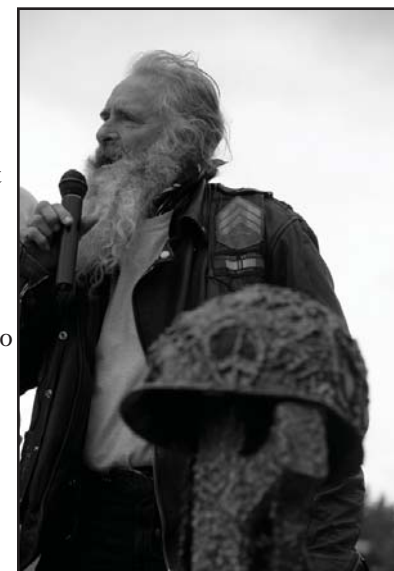

**FROM THE DESK OF JOE WEIGEL:**

Battery operated trailer lights? I know the word "trailer" is a dirty word to many bikers. However, many of us trailer our bikes to Sturgis, Daytona, and other places. Actually, many of us use our trailers for hauling things besides the motorcycle. My own experience is that half the time the trailer lights do not work properly or completely. The good news is that you can get battery operated trailer lights (in case yours stop operating). They sell magnetic ones for farm vehicles at "farm" stores which you can just place against the back of the trailer or the ramp, and you will at least have tail lights. You can also buy tail lights (with the flick of a switch) can be tail lights; turn lights; etc. As a practical matter, you can attach those to the back of your trailer so that you at least have running lights; but you may not want to ask the wife to stand in the trailer and flick them if you are going to turn left or right. Some people strap those lights to their arm when riding a bicycle or jogging.
