Thanks be to God, my family and friends for giving me a new temporary lease on life. So much to say - so little time. It will take the rest of my life to say thank you for the prayers, cards, gifts and letters.

To survive this March 13, 2011 (6:15AM) crash was miraculous in itself. The collision with the overturned SUV lying in the passing lane - sent my Harley and me 342 ft. The front wheel went another 1/4 mile. Completely communicative and coherent from the accident scene to the Emergency Room by helicopter was another miracle of survival. Fifty plus fractures of the left leg, 32 units of blood, 1500 cc of blood clots and blood in the stomach cavity (discovered 4 days later during a spleen surgery). 8 days on the cardiac unit - all demonstrate God's hand upon me.

All of us have or will know the Hand of God and feel the presence of Angels. Unfortunately, some of us won't know until our deathbed. Thank you, Jesus for this opportunity to worship you!
