

## CLASSIC CYCLE - Neenah, WI

At about the time that summer finally starts coming alive, Harley Davidson and Buell motorcycle enthusiasts looking to hit the outdoors will be enthused to hear about a new shop in town that caters to their love of two wheeled freedom. As of March 17, 2008, owners Huntz and Christine Schad have opened the doors to Classic Cycle in Neenah, on the south side of town, just past Copp's Food Center. Located at 1555 S. Commercial Street, Classic Cycle is completely dedicated to the maintenance, service, and repair of Harley's and even Buell motorcycles, old and new, including performance work. Huntz is one of those increasingly rare and hard to find old motorcycle mechanics that's been there, done that forever. With over 30+ years of wrenching on bikes, including 17 of those years in a HD dealership, Huntz Schad is a factory trained mechanic that seriously knows his stuff. His own personal bikes have earned him respect and recognition at bike shows, been featured in various magazines throughout the years, and he's even done performance work on race bikes through his own past lengthy involvement with racing. The customer lounge at Classic Cycle is a testimony to the Schads' 35+ year love of all things motorcycle related, with their own private collection of pictures, and motorcycle memorabilia plastered all over on display. It's a small shop, but the Schad's like it that way, they're determined to keep the overhead down and quality of service high. The shop itself focuses on what Huntz does best, service motorcycles, from old pan heads to most of the newer twin cams, whether it's routine maintenance, repair service, performance upgrades or complete engine rebuilds. "We aren't about selling a bunch of trinkets and other crap," Huntz says, "We're about giving our customers honest, professional service on their motorcycles." Classic Cycle is also an authorized dealer for most major motorcycle parts and accessories suppliers. They accept most major credit cards and cash, but no checks.

The Schads plan on hosting an official Grand Opening party (date yet to be determined) this autumn, as soon as the road construction project on their street is completely out of the way, as well as host rides. Their first official ride will be Saturday, June 14, 2008, and anyone is invited. The second is still in planning stages; it's going to be a "Skip Out of Work Day Ride," to be held on a Wednesday. "Think back to Senior Skip Day in high school, and you'll get the general idea," smiles Christine, adding, "We're declaring that ride to be a mental health holiday for anyone that needs to take a fun break just for one day."
