

2010 BARABOO DELLS AIR SHOW ANNOUNCES SHOW CARD LINEUP

(April 7, 2010) – Baraboo, Wis. Airshows of Wisconsin, Inc., has just announced the show lineup for the 5th annual Baraboo-Dells Air Show, taking place from June 25-27th, at the Baraboo-Dells Municipal Airport. "We are truly excited about this year's air show event," said Paul A. Rogers, the event's director. "We have secured the US Air Force F-16 Viper East Coast Demo Team from Shaw Air Force Base, as well as the Army Silver Eagles Command Exhibition Parachute Team." "Both teams are the best in their category."

"We have also invited people from all over the State of Wisconsin to come to the event, with a special focus on the Harley Riding Groups, Clubs, and other unique groups that focus on traveling to special events." "We are also promoting this year's air show to over 500,000 people in the Milwaukee area, who are expected to attend the Blue Angels Air Show at the Milwaukee Lakefront." "By cross promoting the Baraboo-Dells Air Show with Milwaukee, the area can expect an increase in the areas tourism by attending the air show." "The Baraboo-Dells Air Show is an important, family oriented, educational event for the entire community, and provides a substantial economic impact to the area," he said.

U.S. AIR FORCE F-16 VIPER EAST COAST PREMIER JET DEMONSTRATION TEAM WILL PERFORM AT THE AIR SHOW.

Similar to the U.S. Navy and U.S. Air Force tactical jet demonstration teams that thrilled the crowd during the 2007 and 2009 air shows, the U.S. Air Force F-16 Viper East Coast Demo will perform a stunning series of tactical maneuvers, demonstrating the awesome capabilities of the F-16 Fighting Falcon Jet. "It's one of the best tactical jet demos on the air show circuit," said Rogers, the air show's director. "The team is traveling to Baraboo from Shaw Air Force Base, and to be selected by the Air Force to perform at a small air show such as Baraboo is both an honor and privilege," he said. "Even many larger air shows do not get selected for a demo team, so we are very lucky to get this team."

VINTAGE VIETNAM AIRCRAFTSCHEDULED TO APPEAR WITH THE ARMY AVIATION HERITAGE FOUNDATION HUEY HELICOPTER RIDE PROGRAM

Other exciting addition to this year's air show includes the Army Aviation Heritage Foundation's (AAHF) Huey Helicopter Ride program, which is based in Atlanta, GA. The AAHF is a vintage UH-1 Huey helicopter that flew in the Vietnam War, and will be available to give rides to the general public. Other vintage aircraft include the Douglas AE-1 Skyraider, and the OV-1 Mohawk. Both aircraft are Vietnam era aircraft, and will be on display at the air show. "This is a rare opportunity for the general public to see real aircraft from that era," Said Paul A. Rogers, the air show's director.

U.S. ARMY 101ST SILVER EAGLES PARACHUTE DEMONSTRATION TEAM LANDS AT THE BARABOO-DELLS MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

The U.S. Army Silver Eagles Command Exhibition Parachute Jump Team, based at Fort Benning, GA and very similar in skill and precision compared to the elite U.S. Army Golden Knights Parachute Team, will be in town to kick-off the Baraboo-Dells Air Show with the traditional flag jump during the national anthem. The team will also perform a precision parachute jump demonstration, landing in front of the crowd. "It's a very patriotic and unique air show performance, and a great example of the skill and dedication of the young men and women who serve in the Armed Forces, said Paul Rogers."

FRIDAY NIGHT AIR SHOW SPECTACULAR TO CONTINUE AT THIS YEAR'S EVENT

The Friday night air show spectacular, which has been a big hit so far with the crowds over the past two years, will once again fly on Friday, June 25th, beginning at approx 7:30 pm. The F-16 Demo Team is expected to perform, along with the other air show acts. Gates open at 6pm.


