

I walked into the main building where they had "Panhead" motorcycles on display. They had a good assortment there but some were leaking so much oil that there was a puddle of oil under the bike. All old Harleys are supposed to leak a little bit. I drilled a hole in the primary covers of mine to let the oil that lubed the primary chain leak out. The cutch was a dry one, and when it got oil on it, it wouldn't function. Then there was the rear chain oiler that dripped oil onto the rear chain. If the valve was open too far, it would get the back wheel full of oil and then the back of your shirt too. They were all nice bikes but their owners should have adjusted the oilers to just leak a little- not to puddle.

Then I was surprised to see a Morgan three-wheeler drive into the campground. It was powered by a Harley-Davidson Shovelhead engine. Those are fun cars to drive.

I left about 10:30, and headed back on Rt 49. After a few miles, I stopped at a nice looking 1955 DeSoto Firedome Sportsman. The sign said that it had a 291 cubic inch Hemi engine that ran.
