

### Black and Chrome To Host Tuesday Night Charity Fun Rides

Looking for something to do during the warm summer weekday evenings? Well we have just the thing for you. Starting the first week in June and going through the end of August, Black and Chrome, 8401 Schofield Avenue in Weston (just east of Wausau) will host a weekly "Tuesday Night Charity Fun Ride".

"This is not an original idea," says owner Jackie Strassburg. "Many communities have these going on throughout the riding season. In fact, one of the most successful ones in the nation has been going on for over 18 years right in the Green Bay area at St. Michael's Pub. We are kind of patterning our ride to be similar to that one which has become very successful. They typically draw 75 to 100 riders with some rides drawing well over 300 bikes. We would like this to become a popular and growing event that would involve other businesses helping us out or supporting us.

A typical Tuesday Night Ride route would cover 40 to 60 miles through the country roads while making one or two stops for a beverage break or something to eat, and then finishing up back at the starting area or other designated point. Departure time is usually about 6:30 to 7:00 pm and return between 9:00 and 10:00 pm. Some people will leave from the last place on their own, but usually most will return with the group to the starting point.

For the first few rides, the route and stops will be a surprise, but we hope to get this information out on the web in advance so everyone has an idea where we will be going and stopping each week. Of course, if the weather is bad or rainy, the ride will be cancelled. This is supposed to be a fun ride and there is nothing fun about riding in a rain storm.

Each participant will be asked to donate \$1.00 per rider and passenger (or more if you

desire) to benefit the local charity of the evening, and that money will be given to that charity each week after the ride. We hope to show this area that motorcyclists are a caring and giving group with a passion for their sport of riding around this beautiful free country of ours.
