The cottages are all equipped with a king sized bed, fridge, micro, full bath with whirlpool for 2, screened in porch, grill/utensils, fire pit/ fire logs and a hose if you want to clean off your ride. Dan says, "No One has used the hoses yet, but we figure it's a nice touch."

And just in case your saying to yourself, What is there to do during the day? A reasonable distance from the lodge is the Wisconsin Dells (30 miles) Madison (90 miles) and Lacrosse (50 miles), with excellent not heavily traveled but well maintained roads. Prices at \$165/night on weekends, you do seem to get a lot more than you would staying at an expensive motel. But then again what is it worth to get some real R&R? With Blue




